

# **Erasmus+**Basics of the funding





- max. 12 months for each study cycle (Bachelor, Master, PhD)
- internships between 60 days and 12 months
- internship after graduation: funding possible up to 12 month after finishing your study programme

**NEW:** blended mobilities/ short mobilities combination of a virtual internship and short physical stay abroad at internship company between 5 – 30 days

- Erasmus+ is a financial support, not a full scholarship
- may be combined with other scholarships/funding, e.g. Auslands-BaFöG or Deutschlandstipendium
- Payout in two instalments: 70% bevor ethe beginning, 30% after return

# **Erasmus+**Internships abroad





### What kind of internships can you do within the Erasmus+ programme?

- mandatory or voluntary, payed or unpayed internships
- in any public or private sector relevant to your studies and/or professional career
- may be combined with research and writing of a final thesis
- some universities offer research internships

### Requirements for the internship to be eligible for Erasmus+?

- you are enrolled as a degree seeking student at SRH Berlin
- your internship provider signs a Learning Agreement for traineeships with a description of your tasks and your programme director confirms it
- if applicable, you graduated recently and will finish your internship within twelve months

Please always discuss your plans with your programme director!

# Erasmus+ Internship options





in any programme country, public or private organisation active in the labour market or in the fields of education, training, youth, research and innovation:

- a public or private, a small, medium or large enterprise
- a public body at local, regional or national level
- embassies or consular offices of the sending Programme Country
- a social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions
- a research institute; a foundation
- school/institute/educational centre
- non-profit organisation, association, NGO
- a body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services

# Grants Erasmus+ Blended Mobilities/ Short mobilities





Stay abroad must last between 5 - 30 days, it does not matter how long the virtual component of the internship is:

The base amounts of individual support are set as follows:

| Duration of the physical activity | Amount (any Programme or Partner Country) |
|-----------------------------------|---|
| Up to the 14th day of activity    | 70 EUR per day                            |
| 15th to the 30th day of activity  | 50 EUR per day                            |

It must be possible for students to acquire at least 3 ECTS during a blended mobility.

# Grants Erasmus+ Fewer opportunities





### Top Up of +250€/ month for students who are part of one of these groups:

- Degree of disability of at least 20%.
- Chronical desease
- Travellers with children
- First-time academics (students from a non-academic home)
- Working students

For the proof of one of these aggravated conditions, supporting documents or a declaration on honour are required.

## Grants Erasmus+

### Green travel - sustainable travel





Financial incentive for environmentally friendly travel

#### **Travel costs:**

unique payment of 50€

+

#### **Additional funded days**

up to 4 days additional funding via individual support

train, bus, car-sharing, bicycle....





# **Erasmus+**Application process





#### **Deadline**

- 6 weeks before you start your internship, if the money should be paid in advance
- We accept applications as long as the funding is covered!
- If you hand in your application after you started your intenship, we can fund you from the day your completed application has arrived.

### **ERASMUS+ applications documents:**

- Application form
- enrolment certificate from SRH Berlin (CampusNet or student service)
- Learning Agreement for traineeships (part "Before the Mobility") template provided by International Office
- Confirmation of internship company (copy of contract or similar)

# **Erasmus+**Application documents





#### Further documents provided by the International Office:

- Proof of eligibility and further participation
- Proof of insurance coverage
- Grant Agreement (contract on amount and period)

### **OLS-language test**

- obligatory for Erasmus+ mobilities, except for native speakers
- Link will be sent by email

### Send all application documents to <u>internationaloffice.hsbe@srh.de</u>

**Plan ahead!** Inform us as early as possible about the country and duration of the stay so that we can take this into account in our budget, if necessary, we will apply for more funding.

# Erasmus+ scholarship





### First instalment before/at the beginning of your internship

### Second instalment after you completed the internship

Hand in the following documents as soon as possible:

- Learning agreement "After the mobility"
- Confirmation Letter
- EU-Survey sent by email
- experiences report for future Outgoing students (word doc, video, blog, poetry)

# PROMOS internships worldwide









### What kind of internships can you do with PROMOS?

- mandatory or voluntary, payed or unpayed internships for degree seeking students at SRH Berlin
- in any public or private sector relevant to your studies and/or professional career
- may be combined with research and writing of a final thesis
- possible funding between finishing a Bachelor's degree and starting a Master's degree

Please always discuss your plans with your program director!

#### Please note!

Internships for which special internship programs from the DAAD can be taken advantage of are not eligible for PROMOS funding.

(at EU institutions, non-governmental organizations, institutions/organizations that administer EU programs, as well as at German foreign representations)

### **PROMOS**

### Basics of the funding



Internships must last between 6 weeks and 6 months

#### monthly grants

2023:

350 till 550 Euros depending on the destination country

- one payment before starting the internship
- PROMOS is a financial support, not a full scholarship
- may be combined with other scholarships/funding, e.g. Auslands-BaföG or Deutschlandstipendium

# PROMOS Application documents







- application form
- enrolment certificate from SRH Berlin (CampusNet or student service)
- current transcript of records (CampusNet or examination office)
- motivational letter
- proof of language skills
- CV
- recommendation letter of one of your professors or lecturers
- internship confirmation or contract

## **PROMOS**Deadlines







— Fill out the documents and send them to internationaloffice.hsbe@srh.de

Deadline: 15.06.

We accept applications as long as the funding is covered!

If you hand in your application after you started your intenship, we can fund you from the day your completed application has arrived.

#### Plan ahead!

Inform us as early as possible about country and length of your stay, we include that into our budget or ask for more funding, respectively

### Other financial options

#### **BAFöG** for internships

- only for mandatory internships abroad of at least three months
- primarily for German citizens; international students are eligible under certain circumstance => see <u>website</u> (in German)

#### **Foundations**

HAW. international – DAAD (German Academic Exchange Service)
 scholarship database (in German) – not combinable with Erasmus+ or PROMOS

#### **International students**

— is there support from your home and/or in your internship host country?

### Check local funding opportunities in your host country

— e.g. accommodation allowance <u>CAF in France</u>

### Don't forget!

### If you found a partner institution for an internship:

- Apply for a visa if necessary, it can take a lot of time!
- Take out sufficient insurance coverage (health, accident, liability insurance)!
- Find accommodation!
- Plan your trip!
