Exam Period	Exams usually take place during the last week of each semester.		
Grading System	Final grades are determined by: Mid-term or final exam, attendance, participation, essays, quizzes, presentations, term papers, etc.		

Orientation Period	A mandatory two-day orientation period takes place prior to course start.		
Application	Please send the following information via email to our office: student's name, birthdate, email, phone number, postal address in Europe for visa documents, study program, length of stay at UNCW (1 or 2 semesters). Students will get a link and password for registering at UNCW's online application portal Students can register for their courses there. To apply for a study abroad semester at University of North Carolina at Wilmington, you will need to submit the following documents:		
	• Transcript from home university in English (including signature and stamp of the home university)

	Master students: Bachelor diploma in English		
	• English proof (TOEFL 71, IELTS 6.0, Cambridge FCE/CAE, Duolingo English Test (DET) at least 95 or a DAAD of at least level B2)		
	Proof of Financial Support in English		
Application Deadline	Application deadline is <b>April 1</b> for the fall semester and <b>October 1</b> for the spring semester. Late applications can often be accepted. For a study abroad semester please contact your home university's international office for individual internal deadlines.		
Visa	As a study abroad student, you will enter the United States on a J1 or F1 visa. Students can request a visa only after their application has been approved. Visas can only be requested at US embassies and consulates.
