Selection procedure	Complete applications are handed over to the head of the relevant study programme leader and the teachers concerned, who in turn examine the applications in detail. Applicants will be selected on the basis of the quality of their application, their artistic level and human resources. All applicants will be informed about the selection result within 4-6 weeks after application. Successful applicants will receive: • An Acceptance Letter • A Student Welcome Guide • A Course List (to complete the Learning Agreement)
Language of instruction	We expect a profound knowledge of <b>English (B2)</b> from all students. <b>Basic knowledge of German (B1)</b> is strongly recommended as a lot of lectures are held in German. Ensemble and main subject lessons are thought in German alongside with English.
