### Library Online Resources

The SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences offers a wide range of online resources sorted by subject area.

On our [homepage](#) you will find in the "Research" section freely accessible media as well as e-books, e-journals and databases, our online catalogs for researching print media and catalogs for researching print media and e-books, as well as [OPUS](#) - a digital reference tool for publications of our university members.

For the use of our licensed offer an authentication with the SRH e-mail address and password is required. If you have difficulties with the authentication, please contact our [IT](#).

Numerous of free scientific publications can be found on the information platform [Open Access](#). It offers a thematically wide range of different online resources (journals, repositories, databases, ...).

Likewise, [JSTOR](#) offers numerous resources in the open access area.

The scientific networks [ResearchGate](#) and [Academia](#) also offer access to an internal database of scientific literature in various fields after a registration, which is completely free.

If you need assistance with researching economics literature, you can contact the [EconDesk](#) team online. They offer help with literature research, searching databases, defining technical terms and provide information on companies and countries.

For your research, you can also use scientific search engines such as [BASE](#), [EconBiz](#) or [Google Scholar](#).

An overview of scientific databases from libraries all over Germany can be found at [DBIS](#). There offer numerous freely available databases with different subject areas. Many of them are freely accessible on the web.

The electronic journal library [EZB](#) offers a complete overview of e-journals throughout Germany. Many titles are accessible for the SRH or are freely available on the Internet.

You can do as usual your research in the [Primo knowledge portal](#) of the Technische Universität Berlin. By using the filter "Open Access" you will have direct access to the search results.

For students in Dresden it is worthwhile to have a free membership at the SLUB Dresden (Saxon State and University Library). The Online registration can be done [here](#).

You can download free electronic publications from various publishers (e.g. transcript or De Gruyter) via one of the major online bookstores such as [Thalia](#) or [Hugendubel](#) by entering the publisher's name, searching for e-books, and then sorting by "Price: ascending"

Access to high-quality and free open-access-journals and books can be obtained via the [Directory of Open Access Journals](#) and the [Directory of Open Access Books](#).

[Nomos](#), [Rheinwerk-Verlag](#) and [transcript Verlag](#) also offer free full-text E-Books.
